Very mature Blue Birman lad, just over 6 years old of wonderful Birman type, super broad head, with lovely full cheeks, with most attractive full ruff, framing the head that just completed the overall look. Correct medium ears, set well apart. Very expressive almost round eyes of a beautiful blue. Medium length to nose with slight dip to profile. Well developed chin, with good level bite. Nice full length to massive body showing excellent boning and substance of a very good muscular feel and look (just what the Birman should be), set on medium length legs with thick set paws. Very nice even front gloves, back socks slightly uneven, Lovely full even length gauntlets almost to the hock, just what I like to see. Very nice full coat, showing good length and had a most pleasing silky feel to it, of a most attractive bluish white showing an attractive contrast to the even blue/grey on ears, legs and on a lovely medium bushy tail. Excellent grooming and show preparation to this very handsome lad, not a hair out of place. A most attractive lad who had such a serene laid back expression, his temperament was superb; he purred the whole time and was a pleasure to judge and to award the Grand to. It has been a few years since I last judged this handsome lad; he certainly has matured and is in his prime.

Dense seal to ears, mask, legs and on medium length, tail. Nice even front gloves, with almost matching socks, lovely almost full even length gauntlets, almost to the hock, just what I like!! For just 2 years and four months I liked the size, length and boning to this lad, who had a nice muscular feel, with medium size legs, with thick set paws. Excellent grooming and show preparation to this attractive lad, nice soft silky texture to his coat, showing contrast to his seal points. A very friendly lad who was a pleasure to handle, he just purred and purred, the

perfect gentleman, the best of this lad is to come, but very nicely shown and well done.

Beautiful expressive almost round eyes, of a very good blue. Correct medium nose, showing slight dip to profile, good depth to chin and good bite. For 3 and half this girl has excellent boning and substance to her body, which was of medium length, showing a nice muscular feel and look, set on medium length legs with . Even Tortie markings on ears, mask, and on a nice full bushy tail, showing correct intermingling of seal brown with light cream. Nice even white front gloves, with quite good matching socks, nice full length to both gauntlets, right has a little flick of, but does not extend over the side of leg. Nice full coat showing very attractive fawn colouring to body, showing uneven pale brown with red to the sides. Overall nicely prepared, and groomed, although underneath was a little untidy. A very friendly girl who was nicely shown and had a most pleasing serene expression with a lovely temperament to match.

Medium length to nose with very slight dip to profile, good depth to chin, with nice even bite. Beautiful almost round eyes of a stunning deep blue. Very even attractive slate grey to ears, mask, legs and on a medium length tail that was full and bushy, in proportion to her body. Nice even front gloves with almost even back socks, both gauntlets although are a little narrow and short they were acceptable, pristine white. Although not a big girl she has good weight and boning and good substance. Excellent grooming and show preparation to this lovely girl, showing very pleasing bluish white tone throughout her coat, that was a little bit short. A very attractive girl who has such a serene expression with a very sunny temperament. A lovely lady beautifully shown well done.

Big mature girl of good type, good top to head showing good width, cheeks fairly full, for perfection needs more fullness, giving of a pinched look, although when out of pen, looked better. Good ear set, well apart. Almost round eyes, of a gorgeous deep blue, showing faint spectacles around eyes and at whisker pads. Medium length to nose with slight dip to profile, quite good depth to chin, good even bite. Solid Seal

Tabby Ears, showing thumbprints, very distinct M to forehead, nice even seal tabby barring to legs, set against an agouti background, also on medium length tail that was quite bushy, showing nice rings. Even front gloves, with almost even back socks, very nice almost full even length gauntlets, all feet sparkling white. It has been a long time since I have judged this girl; she certainly has matured and filled out, with very good length, boning and substance with medium thickset legs with firm short paws. Excellent grooming to this lovely girl, who had a nice full coat, showing a most attractive golden hue set against a pale agouti background. A very nice girl who has matured and was beautifully shown, with a very sweet temperament. Well shown.

2nd Carters Innuendo News of the world 13c15 25/8/07 Red Tabby. A very young girl, who was slightly immature but showing good type for her age. Quite good width to head with cheeks developing, but will benefit for more fullness, which should come as she matures and develops. Ears of correct size, showing correct set, solid red in colour with clear thumb prints. Lovely almost round expressive eyes, of a very good blue, showing very light spectacles. Correct medium length to nose, pink, with slight dip to profile, good firm chin & level bite Distinct M to forehead, with faint tabby barring to medium legs, with short firm paws. Front gloves were nice and even, there was white below the pad, but as the colour is still developing, it may well develop. Almost even back socks, lovely full wide gauntlets almost to the hocks. I liked the length and size of this girl although she at present lacks the bulk, but she is young and hopefully will fill out. Very even red to the points, with distinct tabby barring to legs and on a lovely full medium length tail. A very friendly girl who was beautifully shown, in good condition, her coat was beautifully prepared, soft pale cream colouring, showing a very attractive golden halo to her coat. Just a little immature today, but she has time to mature and come into her own, very nicely shown.

Tabby Birman Kitten Male

How lovely to have Birman kittens to judge, it has been a long time since I judged the Kittens and today I had two very handsome Tabby lads who both deserved 1st today, not to mention a very sweet tabby girl.

1st&BOB Butlers Snowshadow Blue Lagoon 13c12 8/5/08 Blue tabby. A very striking attractive boy who was of an excellent size who was just over 5 months. Lovely Broad head, with good breadth to skull, nice full cheeks. Nice medium ears showing correct set, well apart, with solid blue, very distinct thumb prints. Beautiful almost round eyes of a beautiful deep blue, with light spectacles, also showing distinct spotted whisker pads. Nice medium nose with slight dip to profile, very good firm chin & good level bite. I was very impressed with how clear

the tabby markings on this lad were for just 5 months old. Definite M to forehead, with distinct Tabby barring to legs and on a lovely full medium length bushy tail that had very attractive ghost rings. Front gloves were even and acceptable, the white goes to the stopper pad on both, almost level back socks, very good length to almost even gauntlets, all feet sparkling white. I rather liked the size, boning and substance to this handsome lad, good length to his body with nice medium thick set legs and short firm paws. Very attractive even blue to points that intermingled nicely on ears, head, legs and on tail, showing a most attractive beige agouti background, beautiful off white bluish in tone on an expertly groomed coat, silky in texture of a good length. A very handsome lad who really sparkled and showed himself off very well, his temperament was wonderful, a pleasure to judge, well done.

2nd Beaumont's Jandora Just Starsstripes 13c13 24/2/08 Choc tabby. Another lovely lad who was unlucky to come up against the winner today, very little between them. Lovely Birman type, nice broad head, with good breadth to the skull, almost full cheeks. Correct medium size ears showing correct set apart, solid choc colour, very faint thumbprints, just gave a nice overall balance look. Almost round eyes of a good blue, with faint spectacles, and faint spotted whisker pad. Correct medium nose, with slight dip to profile, very good firm chin & good even bite. Very good even Choc points to ears, head, M to forehead although there, was much more fainter than the blue lad Choc colour was paler on legs and on a nice full bushy medium length tail that the tabby barrings were faint but there, showing a nice contrast to the beige agouti background. I do realise it is more difficult for the dilute colour and took this into consideration. Nice full front gloves, the right slopped off but did not extend past the pad, good almost level back socks, very nice full even length gauntlets of a good even width, all feet were pristine white. Although not as big as the Blue lad, this very friendly attractive lad was of a good size of excellent boning & weight showing good substance on medium length thick set legs with firm short paws. I was impressed with the grooming and show preparation to this handsome lad, whose coat was sparkling, showing a very attractive ivory colouring. A lovely lad who was the purrfect gentleman. What a pity the colours were not spilt as both theses handsome boys deserved 1st today.

Tabby/Tabby Tortie Birman Kitten Female

1st Methven Ladypaws Whirlygig 13c11 9/6/08 Seal Tabby. What a poppet this lovely kitten was, she really was a charmer who I liked very much. Beautiful type, lovely broad rounded head, with excellent depth to skull. Lovely full cheeks, correct medium size ears, set well apart. Lovely shaped, almost round eyes of a gorgeous blue, showing spectacles, (they sparkled with mischief) with spotted whisker pads. Correct medium nose, with

gentle dip, excellent depth to firm chin, with lovely even bite. Nice solid seal to ears with clear thumbprints, distinct M to forehead, quite good tabby barring on legs of medium length thickset with firm strong paws, and on a nice medium length tail showing faint rings. Very nice even front gloves, on the right glove white goes up and is level to the stopper pad, nice even back socks with very good even full length gauntlets. For just 4 months old this girl was of a very good size, with very good boning and substance with good weight. Nice soft coat that was beautifully groomed and presented, showing a nice pale beige colour with a faint golden hue. A very appealing kitten who really sold herself and was so playful, when she grows and matures will be a real beauty and hopefully will have a bright future ahead of her. I could have taken her home with me she was so sweet and she adored all the attention. A lovely girl beautifully shown

Norwegian Forest Kitten Male

I was delighted to discover there were 9 Norwegian kittens entered under me and thank the Norwegian Forest exhibitors for their excellent entry under me it was a pleasure, to meet and speak to most of you after judging had finished. There were two Male kittens entered, both were present.

1st Handy's Norskmagi Tavaris 67 31ts Silver Tabby & White 24/6/08 A young lad of very good Norwegian type. Nice triangular head, showing pleasing equality to sides, nice full length to straight profile, with slight rounding to the forehead. Very good firm chin, showing good depth, good level bite. Nice Large ears with good width to base, held high & open showing a very evident line from head line, done to the chin, which gave a most pleasing triangular shape to the head. Very alert large opened eyes oval shaped eyes with oblique set well opened eyes of an attractive amber colouring. Although this lad was just under 4 months he was of a good stature, good length with good bulk for age, he has the muscular look, yet to develop the feel, set on high set legs, the rear being higher than the front, good substance to the legs, with large round paws, with tufts between the toes. I was impressed with the coat texture and length for one so young, correct woolly overcoat covered with a smoother undercoat, with long coarse, glossy hairs on the back and sides, complimented by a lovely long tail, up to the shoulders, showing very attractive Silver tabby markings throughout coat and body, with white against the tabby markings. A very pert friendly kitten who took all in his stride and looked the part, a very typical Norwegian look in type and coat, a pleasure to handle and judge.

2nd Bate's Fenrisulven Kenzo 67 18

Silver Tabby 21/4/08 A bigger lad than the winner of fair type. Quite good triangular shape to the head shows equal sides. Slight rounding to head evident. Profile was almost straight had slight bump at the end. Good

depth to strong chin, quite even bite. Ears were smaller than I would have preferred and were held quite low, lying over head, which did not give the desired height or openness I would have liked, Head line to chin was not as evident, due to ear set, he is young and has time to develop. Alert expressive eyes showing oblique set of nice amber colour. I liked the size and boning and body length to this lad, who will be a big lad, showing a nice muscular feel to him, set on firm set legs; rear higher than front, with large round paws. The texture to this lad's coat was rather soft and short, did not have the correct feel and did not have the coarser long hairs down the back or sides, nice full length bushy tail, just below the shoulders. Very attractive Silver tabby markings to head, body legs and tail that was long and bushy up to the shoulders. A very friendly lad who was beautifully shown.

Norwegian Forest Kitten Female

A very good class of 7 girls entered with some very attractive kittens indeed.

1st & BOB Hall's Bagins Field's OfGold 67 20 Brown Tabby 29/1.08 . A very mature girl, who is almost an adult and the oldest in the class. Wonderful Triangular head, showing most pleasing equal sides. Excellent long straight profile, Correct slight rounding to forehead, super firm chin, and good level bite. Large ears with good width to base, lovely lynx tufts at tips, with long hair from ear, she had a tendency to hold them flat, but when out and looking up, gave the correct high set, showing, a most pleasing triangular look with line from head down to the chin, this made all the difference. Lovely expressive oval well opened eyes of a beautiful green, with oblique set that held my attention, I had the feeling I was being assessed. Excellent bone and substance to this lovely girl who was of an excellent size, strong build with a very muscular feel, showing a strong neck with good deep chest. High legs with rear longer than the front set on firm legs with large round paws showing very attractive tufts between toes. Excellent coat texture and length, correct woolly undercoat, with smooth overcoat, with attractive coarse long hairs down sides and flanks, with lovely brown tabby markings to head, body, legs and tail that was full and bushy up to the shoulders. A very impressive girl who stood out in this class, my only concern was her ear set, but did give the desired look when out of her pen and I weighed everything up making allowances for being almost an adult, which I felt merited 1st & BOB today.

2nd Davis's Rowgarner Gabriela 67 31 ats Blue Silver Tabby & White 26/4/08 A much younger girl who had very good type, lovely triangular head, with quite pleasing equality to the sides. Profile was of a good length, but had a bump at the end with the nose being quite narrow, at the sides. Gentle rounding to the forehead, quite good depth to the chin, good level bite. Ears were of a good

size had good width to base, set high and open, lacked tufts and hair from ears. Eyes I felt were a little small but of a very alert expression oval in shape with oblique set of very nice amber. Nice head line down to the chin, which gave a nice even triangular look to her head. For 6 months old this girl was of a good size with substantial boning and substance with high legs, rear high than front, set on large round paws, with some tufts between toes. Nicely prepared coat, that was quite short but did have a woolly undercoat, with smooth overcoat, she did not have the coarser long hairs to back and flanks, with good length to tail, to the shoulders. Nice attractive blue & silver tabby markings, with white. A very friendly girl who was a pleasure to handle and ran the winner close, lost out to maturity, etc but I am sure she will make it. Very nicely shown.

3rd Fishlock & Lomax Adatelo Pennyparfaitdamour 67 31gt Blue tortie Tabby & White 15/4/08. Young girl who was just 6 months old. Quite good triangular shape to head, nice equal sides. Nice full length to profile, slight bump at end. Correct rounding to forehead, reasonable depth to chin, bite was level. Ears were of a good size, slightly flared in appearance, just a little close, but have good width to base, showing slight tufts and long hairs, good head line down from ears, to chin, giving a triangular look. Large alert oval shaped eyes, with oblique set, of a lovely green. Good body length and bone structure set on firm set high legs, the rear higher than the front, on large round paws, showing tufts between toes. Nice full length bushy tail to shoulders. Quite nice coat texture and look, although still a kitten coat, smooth on top, with woolly undercoat beginning to develop. A very friendly alert girl who was a pleasure to judge, she purred the whole time and was very interested in her surroundings. Not as mature as the above two but she has time to fill out and mature, very nicely shown.

4th Fishlock & Lomax Adatelo Reine La Chateau 67 31gt Blue tortie tabby & white 15/4/08. Litter sister to the above and very similar in type. Quite good triangular shape to head, showing equal sides, Good length to profile, but again slight bump at end, slight rounding to forehead. Quite good depth to chin, good even bite. Large ears, showing width to base, but held quite low at present, head line not as evident, possibly due to ear set. Similier eye shape and size, with alert oblique set, of a nice green colour. Like her sister above, she has good size, boning and length to her body, set on high legs; rear higher than from, set on firm large round paws, with tufts between toes. Nice length to quite bushy tail, up to the shoulders. Again coat texture very similar to her littler sister above, woolly undercoat developing, with smooth overcoat, lacks the coarser longer hairs to flanks and sides, she is only just 6 months old, and she has time. A very friendly girl, who was lovely to handle,

very interested in what was going on, her ears need to sit higher, this should come. Very nicely shown.

5th Fishlock & Lomax Adatelo Empress Elizabeth 67 31et Tortie Tabby & White 15/4/08, The third of the trio of litter sisters but of better type and size. Lovely triangular shape to head, showing most pleasing equality to sides. Nice length to straight profile, slight rounding to forehead, very good firm chin and good level bite. Large ears, with good width to base, set high and open, showing a lovely head line down to the chin, giving a most pleasing triangular appearance.. Very expressive large oval eyes with oblique set of a nice amber, showing an alert expression. Very good size, boning and length to this girl, who had a nice muscular feel to her, unfortunately her legs were rather low and even, lacking the high set required. Very good length to coat with a nice texture, woolly undercoat, with smooth Overcoat, showing long coarser hairs to the back and flanks, of very nice Tortie, tabby and white colouring, balance by a nice full length bushy tail, up to the shoulders, unfortunately there is a slight kink at the end, confirmed by duty vet. A very attractive girl who was so friendly and purred the whole time and in my opinion the better type etc of the three sisters, unfortunately due to her incorrect leg set and kink on her tail I had no option but to place her 5th, which was a great pity as she would have been higher placed. I did speak to her owners who were very gracious and understanding.

The boning, size and substance to this lovely girl was simply divine, big and massive, just what the standard requires and so good to see. The condition to this girl who is just over 11 years old was superb, she gleamed with health, excellent grooming to her full coat, nice and silky, covering her body, there was some shading but was paler at the roots. A most beautiful Birman lady who oozed Birman type and had a most serene expression, her condition and temperament was outstanding. I was delighted to have her today and a pleasure to award her the PC & BOB.
