GCC Hay's Gr Ch Adfurlo Glenkens Glayva 13c11 Seal Tabby Birman 29/10.03. Mature Beautiful girl of excellent Birman type. Superb broad rounded head, with excellent width to full apple cheeks. Correct medium size ears, set well apart. Medium dip to profile, very firm chin & good bite. Almost round very expressive eyes of a beautiful blue, very attractive light spectacles, around eyes and at whisker pads. Correct reddish brick colouring to nose leather, Good solid Seal on ears with faint thump prints, lovely dark seal to this lovely lass points, set against a pale agouti background. Clear M to mask, Dense Seal Tabby barring on legs, and on nice medium length tail, nicely intermingling against agouti background. Lovely even front gloves, with almost matching socks, super full even length sparkling white gauntlets. Excellent boning and weight to this lovely girl, who was of a good length, set on thickset sturdy limbs. Excellent grooming and presentation, to this girl, who had good length to her coat, for time of year, with very attractive pale beige, against a light golden hue, giving a most pleasing contrast. A very affectionate girl, who purred and purred, I have not seen this lovely girl for some time (Lakeland & District June 07) I awarded her the Grand then and today it was Grand Number 3 from me, I guess I like her!! A beautiful cat with such a serene disposition, I see she won the Imperial today, number 4, I understand, I am sure it will not be long before she achieves it.. A real pleasure to judge and award, well done.

Norwegian Kitten MN Open Class

1st & BOB Clark's Nor-Schmikel 67 31ts. 228/12/07. Silver Tabby & White Norwegian. A very pert lad, who was of a good size and length of body for just under 7 months old. Nice triangular shape to head. Correct long straight profile, with no break. Slight rounding to head evident. Good depth to chin, clearly at the teething stage, otherwise bite seems to be ok. Large ears, showing very good width to base, open with tufts showing like. held a little low, but when out, had a more truer appearance and set, quite good head line from ears to chin evident, particularly when out being judged, giving a more pleasing triangular shape to head Very expressive large alert eyes of a

pleasing green, showing the desired oblique set. Excellent length and substance to this lad's body, beginning to show a nice muscular look and feel to it, he will be a big lad, set on firm high legs, the rear higher than the front, nice large round paws, with tufts between toes. Excellent show preparation to this lad who had a smooth overcoat, undercoat still to develop, quite good length to this lads coat. Lovely long full bushy tail going to the shoulders. A very handsome young lad, who is quite mature, who was beautifully shown with a fabulous temperament. Having spoken to his owner after judging, I discovered this was his and his kitten's first show, I hope they both have a very long enjoyable and successful show career

Ac Bicolour Ragdoll Kitten

1st & BOB Gillan's Vonvarda Toyah 66 31a Blue Bicolour, 1.4.08. What a beautiful kitten so friendly and full of personality. Nice broad head, showing a most pleasing flat plane and good width between medium sized ears, rounded at tips, already showing a pleasing tilt forward. I was pleased to see this lovely girl already has well developed cheeks with a nicely developed muzzle, very good firm chin, at the teething stage at present. Correct medium nose, with a gentle dip, showing a very slight retrousse to tip. Very expressive large well opened eyes, showing a slight oblique setting, of a stunning deep blue. Nice soft pale even blue to this girl's ears, mask, legs and on a nice full length tail, in proportion to her body with slight tapering to tip, quite full and bushy. Very distinct clear inverted white V coming from forehead downwards covering a cute pink nose, whisker pad, chin but not going past the outer aperture of the eye. Nice clean white bib, chest and underbody, nice all white front legs, with back legs white to underbody on the left there was a small patch of blue colour at bottom of right paw, that went into the paw pad, the rest being pink, left paw pad was all pink, as its not a listed withholding fault, I did not penalize an otherwise excellent example of the breed., For 3 and half months old this girl was of a very good size and length of body, with a good firm feel to her carrying good weight and boning.. Nice medium length legs, showing good substance with large round paws, with tufts between toes. A very friendly kitten who was beautifully shown, her coat was white with a faint hint of blue, showing a most pleasing contrast to her pale blue points. Although on her own today, she was a worthy winner, nicely shown & presented.

AC Colourpointed /Mitted

1st & BOB Picton's Vonvarda Zoe 66 a Blue Colourpointed, 1/4/08. Young blue Ragdoll girl of nice type, head developing nicely, shown a nice flat plane, quite good width between medium sized rounded ears, held a little high at present, also tilt forward not as evident yet, this should come as she

develops. Cheeks are well developed for her age, with quite good depth to chin, at the teething stage at present, just needs a little more depth to muzzle, hopefully this will come. Medium length to nose showing a gentle dip to profile with slight retrousse to tip. Large well opened eyes, showing the correct oblique set, the lighting did not help, giving the impression of being pale but were of a better blue when I assessed them in the shade. Even shade of blue to this girl's ears, mask, legs and on a full length tail, very much a kitten tail, but showing a slight taper to the tip. I see this kitten is the half sister to the above and is very similar in size, boning weight and substance for her 3 and half months, set on nice medium firm legs, with large rounded paws, shows tufts. As with the above the grooming and presentation to this kitten was excellent, with a nice soft silky coat, showing a pleasing bluish white tone, giving pleasing contrasts to her blue points. A very friendly girl in excellent condition with temperament to match, a pleasure to handle and award today, well shown and well done.

Tabby Point Birman Male Neuter

1 PC & BOB Hay's UKGrPr Glenkens Gallous Gregor 13c11 26/11/98. Lovely mature lad of excellent Birman type, good width to good broad head, with almost full cheeks. Nice medium sized ears set well apart. Expressive almost round eyes of a good blue, good profile, showing a gentle dip, with good level bite, today this lovely lad had a good ruff which gave a better depth to his chin, just completing the look. Correct medium sized ears, set well apart, showing nice solid seal, with faint thumb prints. very distinct spectacles around eyes and on whisker pad, nice clear M on forehead, clear tabby rings on legs lovely tabby rings nicely intermingled on tail that was of a super length and bushy. Nose leather is of a pale pink colour. Super full even front gloves, with matching socks, beautiful full-length even gauntlets almost to the hock, such a pleasure to see. Excellent boning, weight and size to this lovely lad, who is just under 10 years old and looking wonderful, shown in excellent condition, groomed to the last hair as usual. Excellent length and silky texture to this handsome lads coat, full, showing a most attractive golden hue that gave a most pleasing contrast to his points. I last judged this super lad at this show in 2007 where I awarded him the Grand, today it was a pleasure to award him his PC & BOB and he was my nomination for SLH BOV. The temperament to this lad is just wonderful; he is the perfect gentleman and so charming. I understand he was made up today and is now a UK Imperial Grand Premier, my sincere congratulations to him and his proud owner, he deserves it all and it was a pleasure to be part of his special day.

1st Miskelly's Glendavan Masterofillusion

66t Seal Tabby Colourpointed Ragdoll, 29/4/07. What a wonderful big lad of lovely ragdoll type, excellent broad head, showing a most pleasing flat plane, excellent width between medium size ears, set well apart, round at tips, well furnished, showing the desired tilt forward. Cheeks are well developed, muzzle developing, chin just needs a little more depth, should come, excellent level bite. Beautiful large eyes showing the correct oblique set and of a stunning blue, faint spectacle around eyes and with spotted whisker pad. Very good profile showing gentle dip with slight retrousse tip to medium length nose. Nice solid seal to ears showing faint thumbprints, distinct M on to forehead. Nice seal tabby points intermingling with defined stripes to the legs and on a lovely long bushy tail, going to the shoulders tapering and solid colour at tip, set against a light brown agouti background, giving a most attractive contrast. For just 14 months old, this lad was very impressive; he had an excellent long muscular body, with a short neck and chest developing nicely, on firm set substantial boned medium legs, with solid seal to back legs, large round firm tufted paws. I was very impressed with this lad's grooming and show preparation, he had a lovely long silky coat, that gleamed with health, showing a nice ruff, with reasonable knickerbockers, Very attractive light beige colour to coat, showing a paler colour on tummy and chest, give a most attractive contrast to the points. A very impressive lad with a fabulous temperament, he really showed himself off today.

1st Johnstone's Ch Tuyet Quarnara 67 20

Brown Tabby Norwegian Forest 29/5/06. Mature attractive Norwegian girl showing a very pleasing typical Norwegian look. Nice triangular head, showing a pleasing equality to the sides. Excellent long straight profile, correct slight rounding to forehead. Nice strong firm chin, level bite. Excellent ear set, large & well opened showing good width to base, very pleasing gentle line from ears down to the chin which gives of the desired triangular look to her head. Very expressive alert oval eyes with slight oblige set of a nice amber colour. Excellent muscular feel to the body, of good length and substance, on high set legs hind higher than the front, correct firm round paws showing tufts between. Very attractive even brown tabby intermingling on head, coat and on her tail that was of full long and bushy up to the shoulders. The Coat texture was excellent, showing a coarse overcoat with long hairs to the side and back, correct woolly undercoat. A very attractive girl who was nicely presented with a wonderful nature, I see I judged her at the Caledonian LH last October; she keeps on improving, nicely shown.

2nd Hamilton's GrCh Trelgandorf Miss America 64 31 dts Red Silver Tabby & White

Maine Coon 5/1/05. Large girl who today did not look as good as I have seen her, the head seemed rather small in proportion to her body, cheeks needed more fullness, as did her cheekbones. Ears were held flat today, which did not give the desired look, but were set well apart, nice tufts from them. Correct uniform nose showing shallow correct uniform nose, showing shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, correct profile, without break, reasonable square muzzle, good chin and bite. Very expressive full round eyes of a lovely amber colour, set well apart, showing very slight oblique set. Excellent large muscular body of very good length and substance, nice breadth to chest. On firm set legs with large round paws, toes held close, 5 in front, with 4 in back. Not at her best today, coat lacked its usual shine, and some grooming underneath. I liked her lovely Red, silver colouring that intermingled with the tabby markings to the head, legs and on her lovely long tail, wide at base with tapering to tip. A very laid back friendly girl who was a pleasure to handle, not at her best today, possibly time of year.

3rd Miskelly's Glendaven Razzamatazz 66
Seal Colourpointed Ragdoll.29/4/07.Very young girl who was quite immature, head rather triangular, lacking the desired broadness, also more domed in shape. Ears were held quite high and close together, lacking the desired slight tilt forward, quite pointed. Cheeks were not as developed as I would like, reasonable profile, showing a bump at the end, retrousse tip not as evident as I would have liked, chin lacked depth, but bite was level. Large well opened eyes with slight oblique set, of a very good blue. Reasonable length to body with reasonable boning & substance, legs were quite high, set on round smaller paws, with tufts. This girl is just 14 months old, she needs to fill out and mature, but was very nicely shown and presented with quite good length to her silky coat that had a most pleasing beige colour, lighter on the tummy and chest, which gave a nice contrast to her dense even seal on her ears, mask, legs and on her tail that was in proportion to her body. A very friendly girl, who needs to bulk up, broaden out in body and head hopefully she will, otherwise very nicely shown

AV SLH Novice Adult

1st Casey's Kassaro Indianscout 64 16
Blue Mainecoon 8/5/07. Very attractive young lad who shows very good type, correct medium length to head, fairly full cheeks, & high cheek bones. Good firm square muzzle, showing firm chin, level bite. Very expressive full round eyes spaced well apart, showing a slight oblique set, and of a nice copper colour. Uniform width to nose, showing slight concave curve at nasal bridge, without break. Large tall ears, showing good width to base, tapering giving a pointed look, set high & well apart. I rather liked the size and boning this young lad had good length to firm muscular body, with broadness to chest

evident, short thick neck. Firm substantial legs, with round large paws, toes carried close, 5 in front, four behind. Excellent texture to coat that had good length with a woolly undercoat, and correct smooth glossy top coat, shorter at head, neck but with more length down the back and flanks and on a long tail going to the back of the neck, wide at the base and tapering at tip. A lovely friendly lad who was beautifully groomed and shown and he has mature since I last judged him as a kitten at the Caledonian LH show 07.

AV SLH Limit Adult

5 exhibits entered and all present and varied from 9 months to just under 2 years old. I was pleased to award extra prizes.

1st Campbell's Dotcom Lester 64 41W Brown Classic & White Maine Coon. 5/6/07. Large lad but at the adolescent stage, although head was of medium length but was a little short and seemed to be quite narrow. Cheekbones were high but cheeks need to fill out a little, muzzle was a little shallow, but chin was firm, as was bite. Uniform width to nose showing a shallow concave curve at the nasal bridge, without break. Tall ears, with width to base, with taper to tip, set high and a little close together at present. Full round well spaced apart eyes, with very slight oblique set of a nice copper colour. Quite good length to body that is beginning to muscle up, showing good boning & substance for age. Substantiated limbs, with large round tufted paws, toes held close, 5 in front with 4 behind. Coat was quite short still to thicken but well beautifully groomed, showing very attractive Brown tabby markings throughout and on a super full length tail, wide at the base and taper to tip. A most gentle lad who is just at the adolescent stage at present, its all there he just needs to fill out and mature.

2nd McGowan's Bullamoor Sky Dreamer 13c2. Blue Birman, 20/6/07. A very pretty girl of quite good type, good width to top of head, cheeks were a little pinched, as was her chin, good profile shows slight dip, level bite. Ears were set well apart, but a little high at present. Very expressive almost round eyes of a decent blue, the light made it difficult, in the shade they looked a better colour. Very soft powder blue to ears, mask, legs and on a medium length tail that was quite full, I would prefer to see a more slate grey to the points, hopefully this will come as she matures. Very nice clean white almost even front gloves, with almost matching back socks, both gauntlets were of an even length, quite full, sparkling white, off the left gauntlet there was a silvery white colour, which may be a spot developing, the light did not help, in the shade it was inconclusive, therefore I gave her the benefit of doubt today. For just over 1 year old this pretty girl was of good weight, boning, quite a good size, she is young, hopefully she will fill out and mature. Excellent grooming and show preparation, to the coat, just a little too

white, but of good even length. A very friendly girl who was beautifully shown.

Red Mackerel Tabby Maine Coon. A most attractive lad, showing correct medium length to head, quite good cheeks, showing high cheekbones, good depth to chin, good level bite. Uniform width to nose, showing desired shallow concave curve at the nasal bridge, no break or stop, Correct tall large ears, showing width to base, held high, pointed at tip, set well apart. Round full expressive eyes showing a slight oblique set, of pleasing amber. For just 7 months old this lad was of a very good size, with good length to his body with a muscular feel to him, set on firm set legs, with large round paws, toes held close, 5 in front, 4 behind. A very friendly lad who was so playful and was beautifully groomed, with beautiful Red tabby mackerel markings on his coat, legs and on a full long tail, wide at base going up to his shoulders. Quite good length o his coat, a very attractive lad who can only but improve as he develops, what a super nature and beautifully shown.

64 44dw. Red Mackerel Tabby & white Maine Coon Very big lad for just over 7 months old. Good medium length to head, with quite full cheeks, showing good high cheeks bones, large round eyes, slight oblique set, showing space between. I liked the depth to this lads muzzle showing nice square look, good firm chin & good level bite. Uniform width to nose with gentle concave curve at bridge, showing correct profile, without break. Ears were large showing width to base, set high and well apart, tapering, pointed at tip. For his age this attractive lad was of a very good size, good length to body with muscular feel, set on firm set limbs, with large rounded paws, tufted, 5 in front, and four behind, carried close. Excellent grooming and presentation to this lads coat that has quite good length and a very nice feel to texture, with beautiful red tabby mackerel pattern throughout, with white complimented by a very long tail, wide at base up to his shoulder blades, showing tapering to tip. Excellent temperament which just completed the overall picture, a very handsome lad beautifully shown.

2nd Gordon's Brogan's Delight 64 41w Brown classic Tabby & White Maine Coon. Another handsome lad of quite good type, nice medium length to head, cheeks not as well developed as winner yet, quite high cheekbones, large

eyes, showing a nice round shape and green colour. Muzzle developing, good level bite. Nose of uniform width, with slight concave curve at nasal bridge, no break or stop. Ears held high, with good width to base, set well apart, pointed at tip. This lad is 8 and half months old and is of a good size with substantial boning and weight, set on firm set legs, with large round tufted paws, 5 toes in front with 4 behind, carried close. Quite good length to coat that was nicely groomed, showing the typical classical tabby & white through coat, and on a nice full length tail to the shoulders, tapering at tip, and wide at the base. A very friendly lad in excellent condition, with a lovely temperament.

Very small neat rounded ears set well apart, low on head, well furnished and fitting nicely into head, nose although broad was a little too short for me, but within the standard, nose leather well formed. Nice full apple cheeks. Quite firm chin & muzzle, level bite. Lovely large full round bold copper eyes, set well apart, but not deep set. Medium length to cobby body, low on legs that were short and thick, with large round paws, showing tufts, 5 toes in front, with 4 behind carried quite close. Excellent grooming & show preparation to this lovely girl's coat, showing a nice soft texture with even shades of black with red against the white. A very attractive frill developing. Correct short bushy tail that complimented the overall look, a very attractive girl who was a little poppet to handle and beautifully shown, well done.

2nd Matheson's Julescoon Valentine 64 44

dw. Red Mackerel Tabby & White Maine Coon. Large lad of just over 8 months old and of quite good type. Medium length to head, reasonable fullness to cheeks, showing high cheekbones. Large round eyes with slight oblique set, spaced well apart. Muzzle just needs a little more depth, square look to muzzle not as evident, as yet, hopefully will develop. Good firm chin, with level bite. Correct uniform width to nose showing gentle concave curve to bridge, correct profile. Large tall ears with good width to base set high and well apart, showing attractive tufts, and tapering to tip. Very good muscular feel and look to this handsome lad, on a nice full length body, set on firm set legs, with large rounded paws, 5 toes in front, 4

behind, held close. Coat was a little short, summer coat, but beautifully groomed and presented, showing a very smooth soft texture, showing attractive red tabby mackerel markings to head, face, body and on legs, complimented by white, and on a nice full length tail going to the shoulders, wide at base and showing taper to tip. A very friendly young lad who was a pleasure to handle and beautifully showing.

1st Balfour's Pr Norshelian Tor Larsson 67 31ts Silver Tabby & White Norwegian 23/4/06. A mature lad of very good type, correct triangular head, showing excellent equality to sides. Long Straight profile without break. Very slight rounding to forehead evident. Good firm chin and level bite. Large ears, with long tufts, set high, open showing width to base, very good head line from ears down to chin, which gives the correct triangular look to the head. Very alert, expressive well opened oval eyes, showing a slight oblique set, of a very nice green. I was impressed with the size, length & boning this lad carried, he has a nice firm muscular feel to him, solid, with a deep chest & strong neck. Firm high legs, showing hind legs higher than the front, set on large round tufted paws. I was pleased to see this lovely lad had a super full coat, with a lovely thick woolly undercoat, with a nice smooth overcoat, that showed long coarser hairs with glossy hairs that covered his back, sides and on a lovely long bushy tail, up to the neck. When he sat up he had a most attractive Shirt to his front, with a nice full ruff and very attractive knickerbockers, he looked fabulous today. Very nice Silver Tabby & white markings, to head, body, legs and tail that just completed the picture. A lovely friendly lad who was a pleasure to judge, I see he won his PC and Res Grand today, well done.

1st Davies's Yaheshka Avalanche 64 14 C White Maine Coon, Very attractive lad who is almost 19 months old and has certainly matured into a very handsome attractive lad. Correct medium length to head, fairly full cheeks showing high cheekbones. Large tall ears set high, with good width to base, tapering at the tip. Very attractive large round green eyes with slight oblique set. Correct width to uniform nose, with slight concave curve at nasal bridge. Excellent square muzzle, with firm chin & good level bite. Excellent large muscular body, showing depth to chest, neck fully developed. Very firm substantial boning set on firm legs, with large round firm paws, held close, showing correct 5 toes in front, with four behind & tufted. A very confident lad, who really shows himself well when out and was

beautifully groomed and presented, his white coat was gleaming white, with excellent length and texture for time of year, offset with a very full bushy tail, wide at base, tapering at tip and going to the shoulders. I last judged this handsome lad at the Caledonian LH & SLH show last October, he really has matured he has a very endearing temperament and handled very well. Beautifully shown & presented to the last hair.

Correct shape to head, short with a broad wedge with rounded contours, slight broad rounded muzzle & Chin. Slight concave to profile, medium length nose & uniform width, from side view. Low cheekbones that extend to outer ear, with a gentle rounded line to whisker pads & chin. Medium size ears that were rounded at tip, showing good set, wet apart and showing lovely furnishings. Expressive oval eyes of a deep copper, showing slight oblique set, with faint spectacles. Good boning & substance to this lad who had a nice medium length to his body, which was very nicely balanced and still shows a nice rectangular shape. Correct medium legs in proportion to his body, large paws with toes carried close with tufts. Attractive rich red colouring set against his tabby barring on his head, face, legs and tail, up to his shoulders but showing the desired breadth and tapers at tip. showing a nice even intermingling. Again the grooming and presentation was excellent, very good length to his coat. I have not seen this young lad since I judged him at the Caledonian LH & SLH show last October and like then, impeccable manners and excellent presentation.

Fabulous broad head with an excellent flat plane with width between medium size ears, rounded at the tip, showing the desired slight tilt forward. Excellent well developed cheeks, showing a well developed rounded muzzle, fabulous chin, excellent level bite. Correct medium nose length, with gentle dip and showing the desired slight retrousse to tip. Wonderful large well opened eyes set well apart, with slight oblique set, very expressive and of a fantastic deep blue colour. Fabulous deep dense even seal to this beautiful girls, ears, mask, legs and on a nice full bushy tail tapering at tip, up to the

shoulders blades. I loved the size, boning and weight this lovely girl has for being just over 8 years old, very muscular feel and look to her body which is of a good length, with nice short neck & depth to her chest, medium size legs with large round tufted paws. Excellent grooming and show preparation to this girl, who had a lovely full coat, with nice ruff & knickerbockers, of lovely beige giving a most pleasing contrast to her dense seal points. The temperament of this girl is just wonderful, a great ambassadress of her breed, so serene.
