### SLH Imperial Grand Premier MN

#### IGPC McGurk's GrPr Dotcom Imonofire 64 44dw

Red Tabby & White Maine Coon 10/10/07. Very impressive mature striking lad, of excellent type. Nice medium head, fairly full cheeks with good high cheekbones. Correct tall ears set high, with nice lynx tufts, extending, pointed at tips. good width to base. Large round eyes with oblique set, well apart of a lovely copper colour, uniform width to nose, slight concave curve to nasal bridge, no break or stop to profile. Upper lid & nose leather showing perpendicular line Wonderful depth to square muzzle, at first look the bite seemed to be slightly of, however when the mouth was closed the alignment was good, I did consult the duty vet advice on this who felt this was not a problem and the bite was fine. For just over 2 years this very attractive chap carries excellent boning and substance with a very pleasing muscular look and feel to him, nice long thick neck, shows good depth to chest, excellent long body with pleasing rectangular shape, with square rump. Very substantial firm legs with large round tufted paws, toes carried close together 5 in front, 4 behind. Excellent grooming and presentation to this lad's coat, smooth on the top, with a more dense undercoat, shorter fur on head, neck and shoulders but longer down flanks, sides and complimented by a very nice full tail just below the shoulders, but wide at base. Very attractive full breaches and belly fur. Lovely vivid red colouring with a light but pleasing intermingling of tabby giving a very pleasing contrast, to face, body, legs with very clean white chin and paws. A very impressive chap who really was so gentle and took all in his stride, wonderful show presentation and sunny temperament, I see I judged this handsome chap at the very recent West of Scotland CC, he just seems to improve as he is maturing. On his own today but a worthy winner.

### SLH Imperial Grand Premier FN

#### IGPC Coleman's GrPr Skotskatt Bruin Hilde

67 14c White Norwegian Forest 9/11/04. Superb girl of gorgeous Norwegian type. Lovely triangular shape to head with excellent long straight profile, no break, nice equality to sides, slight rounding to forehead, evident. Tall ears held high, pleasing tufts extending from inner ear, open, wide at base, very pleasing headline from ears down to chin giving a most attractive and typical triangular shape. Excellent depth to firm chin, level bite. Very alert expressive oval shaped well opened eyes of a lovely green. Excellent boning & substance to this attractive girl, who is of a good length, nice muscular look and feel to her, good depth to chest and strong neck, set on firm high set legs, rear higher than front with large

rounded paws. Wonderful full length to coat that was pristine white, so clean and glowing in excellent condition, plush woolly undercoat with a smoother overcoat that had longer coarser hairs to the sides back and on nice full length bushy tail, up to the neckline. Very attractive shirt to here front with full knickerbockers. A very attractive lady who is in excellent condition and was very sweet to handle, I have not seen this lovely lady for some time it was a pleasure to judge her and award her the Imperial today, I see she also won the Grand and BOB today, congratulations and well done.

### AC Colourpointed/Mitted Ragdoll Adult Male

#### 1 CC & BOB Lamont's Cattitude Illusion inblu 66a

Blue Colourpointed Ragdoll 17/6/08. I recently judged this super lad at the West Dec 09; I can only but say he just seems to be improving. Wonderful big lad of super type. Nice broad head with pleasing flat plane, showing good width between medium ears, set well apart with slight tilt forward, round at tips and nicely furnished. Nice fully developed cheeks with a nice rounded well developed muzzle, firm chin and nice level bite. Correct medium length to nose, with gentle dip and slightly retrousse to tip. Very expressive well opened large eyes with slight oblique set beautiful deep blue colour. Excellent muscular feel and look to this handsome lad, who was very striking and had presence, correct short neck with good depth to chest, nice length to firm body, set on medium length substantial legs with large round tufted paws. Very attractive even blue to this chaps ears, mask, legs and on a nice full long bushy tail, going to the shoulders and tapering to tip. Lovely soft silky coat of very good even length, nice ruff around neck, with pleasing bluish white tone showing a n attractive contrast to the points, quite full knickerbockers. A very friendly lad who shows himself off to his best advantage, so sweet to handle, beautifully shown, he is not yet 2 years old and already has fully matured, it was a pleasure to award him the CC & BOB today.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Lamont's Happytyme Ragtime Buddy 66 Seal

Colourpointed 24/4/09. Young lad just into adulthood and quite adolescent at present, but he does have a good broad head with pleasing flat plane, cheeks are developing as is muzzle. Quite good width between medium size rounded ears, held straight up at present. Large well opened eyes of a very nice blue, not showing the desired oblique setting, being wide eyed today Good chin, level bite. Medium length to nose with slight retrousse to tip. Dense seal to ears, mask, but much paler on legs and on tail that medium in length, a little sparse today and has brindling. Medium length to body that needs more substance and bulk, hopefully it will develop as he matures, firm medium legs with large round tufted paws. Nicely prepared and beautifully presented coat, soft and silky with t a pleasing light beige tone, against the points. A very friendly young chap who is a little lad in the big boys club, he needs to fill out, broaden and bulk up which hopefully he will do. Very nicely shown indeed.

### AC Colourpointed/Mitted Ragdoll

3 girls entered and all present.

#### 1CC Lamont's Cattitude Deja Vue 66 Seal

Colourpointed 17/6/08. Mature girl of lovely ragdoll type Excellent broad head with pleasing flat plane excellent width between medium size well furnished rounded ears, correct tilt forward. Excellent fully developed cheeks, and depth to a fully developed round muzzle, firm chin and very level bite. Medium length to nose with gentle dip, retrousse to tip. Very expressive large well opened eyes set well apart and slight oblique set, of a very nice blue. Lovely even

dense seal to the ears, mask, legs and on a medium length, full tail up to shoulders. Excellent boning, weight and substance to this lovely girl, who had a good strong, feel to her and good length of body on medium legs, large round tufted paws. Coat although short today was of a nice texture, but had surface shading, with contrasts to her points. It has been a while since I have judged this lovely lady, who I remember from the Caledonian LH 08, my BIS Semi Kitten, she has certainly matured and has developed very nicely, she lost out on the BOB today to the lad, due to coat been shorter, but I understand she is returning after maternal duties, the quality is there, just needs more coat to perfect the overall picture, still the same fantastic temperament, beautifully shown in excellent condition, I understand this is her 2<sup>nd</sup> CC one to go, congratulations.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Hasslet's Happytyme Lass Tumblerag 66** Seal Colourpointed 25/4/09. A very young girl just into adulthood, for me she is a little small and at present lacks the substance, bulk and length, and quite light. Nice broad head with pleasing flat plane, ears a little high set and close at present, but are rounded at tips cheeks are developing as is muzzle, good level bite. Large round well opened eyes, of a nice blue, again like the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed male she was quite wide eyed, not showing desired oblique look as yet. Medium length nose with slight dip in profile, slight retrousse to tip. Seal on ears, mask even and dense but legs were much paler and quite unsettled, as was tail that is of medium length but very brindled and quite sparse at present. I would like more substance, boning and weight and length to her body, medium legs with large round tufted paws, to this girl who is very pretty with a lovely sweet disposition, she also needs to grow and develop which hopefully she will as she matures. beautifully groomed and prepared, with an beige tone to her coat that will show a pleasing contrast to her points when they even out. I will watch her progress with interest.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Miskelly's Glendavan Miss-Deft 66t** Seal Tabby 21/3/09 . Another young girl not long into adulthood, I felt the head on this pretty girl was on the short side, slightly pointed, lacking the broadness, although had a flattish plane, cheeks need more width for a better balance, medium size ears but held tall, rounded and close together. Chin has quite good depth, good level bite. Very expressive large eyes, of a very nice blue, with light spectacles, also at whisker pad. Nice medium length to nose, clear reddish brick nose leather, with pleasing gentle dip, slight retrousse to tip. I felt the Seal tabby markings were not very distinct, although it was there on the ears, there was a hint of a chocolate colouring, very faint thumbprints on ears, mask was very pale, although I could see the M, also the tabby barring on the legs and tail very light, again a hint of chocolate rather than seal, in some parts there was a bluish tone which against the body gave a silver effect, I would have expected a far denser shade of seal, perhaps it will develop as she matures. Quite good boning and substance to this girl, nice medium length body on medium legs with large rounded tufted paws. Coat was very short today, but soft with a silky feel to it and beautifully groomed and presented. A lovely sweet natured girl who enjoyed all the fuss, she needs to fill out and her colour to settle, I will watch this colouring with interest.

#### **Blue Birman Kitten Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB w/h 2<sup>nd</sup> Lamb's Ingamae Elfin Fairy** 13c2 Blue Birman, 18/7/09. Lovely kitten that was a real cutie, so feminine and of lovely Birman type. Lovely broad rounded skull, nice medium ears, set

apart. Excellent full cheeks, with very pleasing gentle dip, good depth to chin & level bite. I was very disappointed to discover a very prominent white spot on the chin; also I noticed there is the beginning on pigmentation loss on the lips. Beautiful expressive almost round deep blue eyes. Lovely slate grey to ears, legs, mask and on a nice medium length tail nice even front gloves, very sadly there is a very large wide runner past the stopper pad on the inside of the left paw. Nice back socks, lovely even full gauntlets. For just over 6 months old this gorgeous kitten has very good boning, weight and substance, with medium legs and thickset paws. A most beautiful kitten who oozed birman type, so beautifully balanced and groomed to perfection, nice soft silky coat with a most pleasing bluish white tinge giving a lovely contrast to her points. What a great pity to find these faults on this delightful kitten, who is so typically blue with a most serene expression with a first class temperament, I just adored this lovely girl, she took me back to the glory days of the beautiful blues, I did speak to her owner and expressed my deep regret; she is clearly loved by her owner who will give her the love she deserves, a super kitten.

#### **Brown /Blue Tabby Series Maine coon Kitten**

Today was my debut as judge for the Maine Coon kittens and I wish to thank the Maine Coon Breeders/Exhibitors for very kindly coming out to support me, it was a most enjoyable and pleasing experience

#### **1<sup>st</sup> & BOB Wilson's Coonsrus Toanna 64 41**

Brown Tabby, 18/8/09 What a beautiful girl this was and what a start for me as probationer on the Maine Coon list. Nice medium head. Nicely developed cheeks with high cheekbones. Large tall ears set high, with good width to base, showing attractive lynx tufts extending, pointed at tips, set well apart, Full round eyes spaced well apart, with a very slight oblique set, of a lovely amber colour. Uniform width to nose with slight concave curve to nasal bridge, no break or stop to profile. Upper lid & nose leather showing perpendicular line. Very good depth to Muzzle, showing a very pleasing squared look, excellent level bite. this gorgeous kitten is just under 6 months old and already is of a wonderful size, carrying excellent boning and body length, good substance and weight, back showing a pleasing rectangular look, rump developing, very substantial limbs, with large round tufted paws, toes, dense black pads, carried very close together, 5 in front, 4 behind. Beautiful Black tabby markings intermingling nicely against a nice warm agouti background. Attractive coat texture, undercoat developing, smoother shinny overcoat that gives a most attractive look to it. Fur to head, neck and shoulders was shorter, but is longer to the sides, back and a lovely full bushy tail, to the neck, wide at base and tapering at tip. I love the tabby pattern to head with distinct M frown on forehead, clear unbroken stripe, with narrow cheek from outer corner of eye with narrow lines to cheeks. Nice unbroken necklaces to chest, neck, clear thump print to ears. Very distinct line above the M over the head, going to the shoulders. Clear butterfly evident from shoulders. Unbroken line down spine from the butterfly to the tail that is of an excellent full length wide at the base, tapering at tip, solid spot, clear stripes to flanks equally. Nice even oysters to both flanks. With attractive rings. Very attractive tabby rings to legs and on tail. Sweetest of temperaments, she really sold herself and is an absolute beauty; I was delighted to have her in my very first kitten class, certainly one to watch. Superb kitten beautifully shown.

**Silver Tabby Series Maine Coon Kitten Male**

**1<sup>st</sup> Mc Geachy's Shawcoon Fantasia Falkor** 64 41sw 3/10/09 Silver tabby & white. Very young pert lad making his debut today, cheeks are developing, reasonable cheekbones. Ears set very high and quite wide, lacking tufts at the tips at present. Eyes appeared to be a little small, but round in shape of a pleasing green colour. Uniform length to nose, with shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, no break or stop in profile. Perpendicular line not quite as evident as yet, reasonable depth to chin, slightly uneven bite (teething), and muzzle is developing. Reasonable length to the body with reasonable weight and substance, he just needs to grow into himself. Firm limbs with large round tufted paws, pads dense black, toes held close, 5 in front, 4 behind. Very attractive Silver with tabby markings to head, not quite as distinct on body or legs, with very clean white to face, legs and underneath, also on nice long tail up to shoulders, very much a kitten tail, but nice silver tabby & white intermingling, slight tapering at tip. A very young lad who just needs time to develop and grow, which hopefully he will, his coat was quite short, but very nicely presented, as it grows the Silver and tabby will become more obvious and the pattern easier to see, there was a slight hint of possible mackerel pattern to sides, but maybe it was the sheen on the shorter coat, which created the illusion. A very friendly little lad who was so sweet, he was so playful

**Silver Tabby Series Maine Coon Kitten Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB Gardiner's Lionmaine Fellpurrs Sasha** 64 41esw Tortie Silver Tabby & White 13/10/09. A very attractive and quite mature kitten, with a very pleasing medium head, nice fairly full cheeks, showing pleasing high cheekbones. Full round green eyes with a slight oblique set. Uniform length to nose, pleasing concave curve at nasal bridge, no break or stop to profile Upper lid & nose leather showing perpendicular line. Excellent square muzzle with good level bite. I rather liked the ear set, large and tall with good wide to base, very attractive lynx tufts extending from inner ear, pointed at tips, set well apart. Very attractive Tortie markings on face, body, flanks and on nice full length bushy tail, wide at the base, tapering at tip, showing excellent contrast with the darker black tabby markings, against the silver background, with the white, giving a most pleasing ghost like appearance. Very faint but evident M to face, with faint tabby markings down coat, and on legs, with a very light agouti background. Excellent coat texture and length, down back, flanks and to tail, but shorter on head, neck and shoulders. I rather liked the size and length of this girl, who at 4 months old is very muscular and carries good boning and substance to her, very firm limbs with the nice rectangular shape, square rump evident, large rounded, tufted paws, pleasing tortie colouring between toes against the black which is very attractive. For me this lovely girl was beautifully balanced and can only but improve as she develops, superb coat presentation, nice smooth top overlay, with quite a woolly undercoat. Excellent temperament and a pleasure to judge, she really is a charmer.

**AOC Maine Coon Kitten Male**

3 lads entered with 1 absent

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB Fletcher's Dragonmaine Firethroat** 64 41d Red Tabby 9/8/09. Wonderful mature lad of lovely type. Nice medium head, with fairly full cheeks, & high cheekbones. Large tall ears set high, with good width to base, showing attractive lynx tufts extending, pointed at tips, set well apart. Lovely full round eyes, pink rims, with slight oblique set, of a lovely copper colour. Correct uniform width to nose

with shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, no break or stop. Upper nose leather (pink) & lips show pleasing perpendicular line. Excellent depth to firm chin, with a fabulous square muzzle, good level bite. I loved the size, boning and substance to this handsome lad who for just over 6 months old shows a very muscular look and feel to him, excellent length to firm body, with substantial limbs, showing pleasing rectangular shape with square rump, firm legs with large round tufted paws, pink paws pads, toes carried very close together 5 in front, 4 behind. Lovely rich red coat colour with very attractive red tabby markings to head, face and on legs and on super full long tail, solid spot Wide at the base, and tapers at tip, set against a very attractive bright apricot agouti background, that gave a most attractive look to the tabby markings, nice clear M frown to face, with narrow cheek from outer corner of eye with narrow lines to cheeks. Unbroken necklaces to chest, neck, clear thump print to ears. Very distinct line above the M over the head, going to the shoulders. Clear butterfly evident from shoulders. Unbroken line down spine from the butterfly to the tail solid spot, clear stripes to flanks equally. Nice even oysters to both flanks. With attractive rings. Super coat texture and length to this handsome lad's coat, fur shorter on face, neck and shoulders but longer to back, flanks and sides and to tail, nice woolly undercoat with top shinny overcoat, beautifully presented in excellent condition. I rather liked this handsome chap who had a fantastic temperament; he is quite something, a super lad who I shall watch with great interest.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Davidson's Swawcoon Aslan Of Narnia** 64 44fw Cream Tabby & White 3/10/09 Very sweet young lad of quite good type, medium length to head, cheeks are developing, high cheekbones. Large ears are at present slightly flared, needs to balance which they should as he develops, lynx tufts extending, from inner ear, pointed at tip. Quite full round eyes, held wide today, (due to lot of noise) but shows the slight oblique set, when in his pen, of a very nice amber colour. Uniform wide to nose with slight concave curve at nasal bridge, no break. Nose leather, (pink) & upper lip shows a reasonable perpendicular line at present, reasonable depth to chin, Squared look to muzzle to develop, quite good bite. Good length 7 size to this friendly chap who has good boning and substance for his age, quite a firm feel to him, with firm limbs with larger round tufted paws, toes held close 5 in front, 4 behind, nice clean pink pads. Attractive even pale cream colouring to the coat, against a slightly darker cream agouti background that was short but smooth on top, reasonable woolly undercoat, very clean white to face, body and legs The tabby markings were quite faint, let to fully develop, but there is a hint to coat, legs and very slightly on nice full length tail wide at base, and going up to shoulders, very much a kitten tail. A very friendly lad who was shown in excellent condition, also making his show debut today, he just needs to mature which I am sure he will. Excellent condition, presentation and delightful temperament.

**AOC Maine Coon Kitten Female**

I was delighted to find 4 kittens entered and all present today.

**1<sup>st</sup> Wright's Powerkatz Roxy** 64 41d

Red Tabby 21/8/09 Very attractive girl who was of a very good size for her age, nice medium length to head, with quite fairly full cheeks, high cheekbones. Large tall ears, with good width to base, nice lynx tufts extending from inner ear, pointed at tips. Large full round eyes of a very nice copper colour, with slight oblique set, pink rims Uniform width to nose,

slight concave curve at nasal break, no stop or break in profile, Upper nose leather (pink) & lips show pleasing perpendicular line. Good depth to firm chin, squared look to muzzle developing, level bite. Excellent size and length to this girl who is just under 6 months old, she has a pleasing strong body frame, with firm substantial limbs, rectangular shape with rump beginning to develop, larger round tufted pads, with toes carries close, 5 in front with 4 behind, pleasing pink pads. Very pleasing rich red to coat that is of a nice texture, woolly undercoat developing with a slightly smoother top overcoat, but short at present, set against a very attractive bright apricot agouti background, Darker red tabby markings on face evident, distinct M frown on face, but the tabby markings not as defined on the legs, body or legs, should even out as she develops, nice rich tabby markings on a nice full length tail, wide at base, up to shoulders. Very nicely presented coat that has a nice shine to it, quite short on face, shoulders, back, slightly longer to flanks, and to tail. A very friendly but shy girl, who liked the security of her pen, it was very noisy when judging this class, but she handled beautifully, very nicely shown.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Wrights Powerkatz My imagination** 64 41ew Tortie Tabby & White 14/10/09. Very sweet attractive kitten who was of very nice type, correct medium head with reasonable cheeks, high cheekbones. Large tall ears, with quite good width to base, set high, attractive tufts from inner ear, pointed at the tips. Very expressive large full eyes of most pleasing amber, with very slight oblique set, pinkish rims. Good depth to firm chin, with a squareish look to the muzzle, bite was ok, at teething stage at present. Uniform width to nose, with shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, very pleasing Upper nose leather (pink) & lips show pleasing perpendicular line. Just under 4 months old this very pretty kitten is of a good size and has good length to her body, she does need to fill out and broaden, which she will as she develops, quite firm set legs with large round tufted paws toes carried very closely, pleasing black paws with hints of tortie fur between toes. Very attractive Tortie, that was evenly intermingled with the black tabby markings, on a soft but very short coat of warm copper agouti background, pleasing hints of red and cream, to ears, face, down body, legs and on a nice full length tail, just a little sparse, today a kitten tail, but up to the shoulders, tapering at tip. Nice white to face, and on body and underneath intermingling with the agouti, giving a pleasing soft look to her undercoat, also to the tail. I rather liked this lovely little girl who was beautifully presented; she had a superb temperament and ran the winners close, just lost out on maturity but her day I am sure will come, beautifully shown.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Milligan's Westflakes Redhot Tottie** 64 41d Red Tabby 25/5/09 the oldest and maturist kitten in this class, of very good type. Nice medium head with fairly full cheeks, high cheek bones. Ears although were large and tall were held very close together, not displaying the desired width to base, pleasing lynx tufts from inner ears pointed at the tips. Eyes were very large and round, pink rims showing an angry expression, this lovely girl was rather frightened and anxious, there was a lot of noise around this which I feel contributed to this girl not showing herself well today. I rather like the depth to the chin with a nice squared look to the muzzle, quite good bite. Uniform width to nose, shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, there was a definite break in profile, bump towards bottom of nose, pink nose leather, I felt the perpendicular line was not as level as it should be which detracted from the overall look. Perhaps her mood made it appear to be so; she did pull in her

muzzle at times. Excellent boning and substance to this girl who has a very firm muscular look and feel to her, good length to body, with firm limbs, nice rectangular shape with rump developing. Large firm round paws with tufts between toes, carried close, 5 in front, 4 behind. Lovely rich red colour to the coat, with pleasing rich red tabby markings, to face, M frown was clear, on body, legs and on the tail that was full, wide at base, going to the shoulder and tapering, contrasting nicely against a rich copper agouti background. Quite distinct line above the M over the head, going to the shoulders. Nice butterfly to the shoulders with unbroken line down spine from the butterfly to the tail solid spot, clear stripes to flanks equally. Nice even oysters to both flanks. With attractive rings. This girl had the best coat texture and length of the girls today, shorter fur on face, head, shoulders, but of a longer length down back, sides and on the tail, nice woolly undercoat with a very smooth top overcoat, giving a very pleasing shine to it. Unfortunately this girl was not happy today which was a great shame and I felt it was in her best interest to have her withdrawn from competition, I did after I had finished try to find her owners to explain, but a very nice big girl hopefully it is an off day.

**4<sup>th</sup> Davies Coonflakes Tequila Sunrise** 64 41e Tortie tabby 7/10/09. Exquisite Kitten, lovely medim length to head, pleasing cheeks, with nice high cheekbone, ears were large, tall with good width to base, high set, very attractive lynx tufts from inner ear, pointed at tips. Full round eyes of a lovely green colour showing slight oblique set, black rims. Uniform width to nose, shallow concave curve at nasal bridge, no break in profile Upper nose leather (reddish) & lips show pleasing perpendicular line. Very good firm chin, with pleasing squared look, unfortunately the bottom jaw was overshot and slightly twisted, confirmed by duty vet. Very good boning, substance and length to this lovely kitten, with firm limbs, rectangular shape developing, firm legs with large round tufted paws, black pads, with pleasing tufts, attractive tortie markings, between toes that ere carried close, 5 in front, 4 behind. Beautiful tortie colouring, contrasting with the tabby markings, against a rich copper agouti background, with shades of red and cream, M Frown a little pale as is markings to the coat, barring on legs and on a nice full tail wide at base, going up to the shoulders, tapering at tip. Fur is shorter on face, head and shoulders but longer to back flanks and on tail, quite a nice woolly undercoat with a pleasing top smoother overcoat. I rather liked this lovely kitten who was such a dear soul, she just purred the whole time, sadly due to the bite I had to place her last, nevertheless beautifully shown in super condition, a little beauty.

#### **Norwegian Forest Female Neuter**

I took over this class and hope the exhibitors were not disappointed in change of judge.
