AC Birman Grand Premier

Four lads enters with one absent,

GPC Butler's Pr Jinglebells Chino 13c1 A very mature seal lad who is just over four years old. Lovely Birman lad with a very pleasing broad rounded head, with nice full apple cheeks, just added to the overall look of this handsome lad. Excellent depth to chin, quite good bite. Correct medium ears, set well apart. Medium length to nose, showing slight dip. Correct almost round eyes of a very good blue. Excellent dense seal to the ears, mask, legs and on a nice medium bushy tail. Nice full even front gloves, with matching back socks, lovely full wide even length gauntlets, all feet sparkling white. Excellent boning, weight and substance, just what the Birman should be, set on low set firm large paws. A very friendly lad, who was beautifully shown, with a nice full soft silky coat, showing beautiful contrast to the points, a most pleasing golden hue. I liked this handsome lad, who just looked so serene and was the perfect gentleman; he stood out in this class. I understand from his proud owner I made him up to Grand Premier, congratulations and well done.

RGPC Seymour's Pr Fancypaws Mr. Beaujangles 13c1. A young lad, who was just over two years old and was a little immature and needs to develop more. Quite good type, good top to head, just needs more width to cheeks for an overall better balance. Good firm chin good level bite, chin just needs a little more depth, hopefully this will come as he matures. Good medium profile, with slight dip. Almost round expressive eyes of a good blue. Nice dense seal to, ears, just a little high, and on mask, legs and on medium length tail, in proportion to the body. Good length and body weight to this lad, who was of good substance, set on medium length legs. Very good front even gloves, with good back socks, very nice full even length gauntlets, all feet nice and clean. Very nicely groomed and presented coat, showing some shading but clear at roots. Excellent temperament and handled nicely. Not as mature as the winner, but a lovely young lad, just needs to mature which hopefully he will, well done.

Tabby Point/ Tabby Birman Female

Four girls entered and present.

1 CC & BOB Thomson's Ch Mlyward Zalkani 13c18 Blue Tortie Tabby A most attractive girl of lovely Birman type, lovely broad rounded head, with lovely full apple cheeks, nice medium size ears,, very faint thumbprints, showing an attractive light cream, against blue, set well apart. Lovely eye shape, of a beautiful blue, showing very slight spectacles. Nice profile, showing slight dip, good firm chin and good level bite. Very good even front gloves, with good matching socks, showing very attractive light beige intermingling against an agouti background, nice distinct clear white even length gauntlets, with desired tortie markings, quite distinct tabby markings, to head, legs and on tail A lovely girl who was beautifully groomed, showing excellent contrast in her coat, light shades of cream, against the agouti mingling with the light blue. I liked the size and boning to this girl, although a little light but she is calling and was very uptight and difficult to handle, but she really is beautiful, she stood out in this class, it was with pleasure I awarded her the CC & BOB today. I see she won the Grand today, well done.

2nd Portsmouth's Adsetlo Lady Snowbell

13c11. A very attractive girl of lovely type, nice broad head, with almost full cheeks. Medium sized ears, just a little high at present, but of a good solid seal, with faint thumbprints Lovely expressive almost round eyes of a good blue, showing nice spectacles. Good profile showing medium dip, with good depth to chin, level bite. Mask not full yet, but has a definite M to forehead, seal tabby markings, faint on legs and on a medium length, full tail, showing faint ghost rings. Nice even front gloves with quite good back socks, right gauntlet was shortish and narrow but on pushing out, made it better, left gauntlet was of a better length, with width. I rather liked the boning, weight and size to this attractive girl, who was just over 11 months but will be a good size. A very friendly attractive girl, who will only but improve as she matures, as will her tabby colouring, just a little pale today. I am sure her day will come but please push out the right gauntlet, it makes a big difference. Very nicely shown.

3rd Carter's Innuendo Made In Heaven

13c18 Blue Tortie Tabby this girl lacked the fullness to head and face, I would have liked for over 2 years old. Quite good top to head, cheeks need more fullness for better balance, quite good profile, although chin recedes, needs more depth for balance, good level bite. Ears were a little high set, but with reasonable width, very faint thumbprints, showing light cream, with a hint of agouti to the background. Tabby markings not as clear, but were there, to head, legs and on tail. Very nice eye shape, of a good blue, showing slight spectacles, with faint cream & agouti. Front gloves low but even, showing a hint of cream, also on back socks, short but okay, gauntlets were very short, but had cream set against an agouti background. Quite good boning and weight, I

would have liked her a bit bigger but she does have quite good substance. Coat was nicely groomed, but a little short, showing a very attractive light cream, intermingling against a faint agouti background, contrasting nicely with the blue. A very friendly girl, in good condition, very nicely shown.

4th Douglas's Felonie Eye Candy 13c14 Lilac Tabby Very much the babe in this class head triangular at present and needs to develop, as do cheeks, she lacks overall balance at present. Ears held high and close together, at present, faint thumbprints, but showing solid lilac to ears. Very expressive eyes of good shape and of a very nice colour, showing faint spectacles. Quite good profile, showing slight dip, quite good depth to chin, good bite. Medium length nose with slight dip. Tabby markings faint, but there, on, mask, legs and on a medium length tail, a little sandy in colour. Front gloves, were low but even, back socks were okay, gauntlets were short but appeared level. Quite good weight to this very pretty girl, who was a little small and needs to grow. Very nice off white colour to her coat, A very pretty girl, who was beautifully shown in good condition but she needs to grow, Super temperament.

Norwegian Forest Kitten Male

3 lads entered and present

1st & BOB

Snelling & Burnett's Norsvana Alfarin AVlote 67 31ats Blue Silver Tabby & white 11/9/07. A very attractive mature lad of lovely Norwegian type. Lovely triangular head, showing equal sides. Excellent long straight profile, without break. Very slight rounding to forehead evident. Very good firm strong chin, good level bite. Large ears, with good width to base, set high and open, with attractive tufts, showing good clear line from ears down the head to the chin, giving off a most attractive triangular and very typical Norwegian look to the head. Very alert and expressive large well opened oval, oblique set eyes showing very attractive amber colour. For 7 months old this lad was of a very good size, showing a good muscular feel to him, with good boning, set on firm legs, rear higher than front, with large paws & tufts between toes. Lovely feel to the coat texture, which had a wooly undercoat, with a smooth overcoat, showing correct thickness, I was pleased to see there were longer coarser hairs on the flanks and down the back, which gave the desired look and feel to the coat, complimented by a lovely long, bushy tail, going to the shoulders. A very alert attractive lad, in excellent condition with a fabulous temperament, he really looked a picture today.

2nd Rowberry Rogarnor Amund 67 18a 6/8/07. Another big handsome lad of lovely Norwegian type. Good triangular head, showing equality to sides. Good long straight profile, with good firm chin. Very slight rounding to forehead evident. Large ears, with good width, set high and well apart, pleasing head

line down to chin, giving a very attractive triangular look, good tufts coming from ears. Large well opened oval oblique set eyes of an amber colour, of a very alert expression. This lad was just over 8 months old and has very good boning, weight and substance; good muscular feel to his long firm body, on firm legs, rear higher than the front, nice large paws with tufts between toes. Good length to coat which had a smoother feel to it, lacking the wooly undercoat at present and was smooth to sides, complimented by a lovely long bushy tail going to shoulders. A very handsome friendly boy, who was beautifully shown in excellent condition, the deciding factor between this lad and the winner was the coat texture, which today determined the placing but I am sure he will do well as he matures.

3rd Szwed's Fernisulven Ven Indiana 67

20 26/10/07 Brown Tabby. 26/10/07 A very young immature lad but has a very good triangular shape to his head, almost equal to sides. Slight rounded to head. Very good long straight profile, showing a good depth to his chin, good level bite. Excellent ear set, high and well apart, with some lynx tufts coming. Quite good head line from ears down to chin, giving a pleasing triangular look for such a young lad. Eyes tended to be a little small and rounded today, although he was very alert and interested in his surroundings, did not have the oblique setting as yet, I understand it was his first show, which may account for his eyes being round today, they were of a lovely amber colour Good size and boning, weight and substance to this pert lad, for just under 6 months, on a reasonable length of body, set on firm strong legs, rear higher than from, with large paws, tufts between. Very attractive Brown tabby markings to the coat, which today was short but beautifully groomed, very smooth, very much a kitten coat, complimented by a good length tail just a little sparse at present. In all a handsome lad, who needs to mature and fill out and was disadvantaged by being up against 2 more maturer lads today. Fabulous temperament and very nicely shown.

Norwegian Forest Kitten Female

4 girls entered with two absent

1st Hutfield's Adatelo Etarre Tatiana 67

31ts 16/12/07 Siler Tabby & White A very pretty girl showing a very attractive triangular shape to her head, with very pleasing equality to sides. Excellent long straight profile, without break, with very firm chin. Excellent rounding to forehead very evident. Large ears, held high and open, just a fraction close at present, nice long lynx tufts coming from ears, showing a pleasing line down the chin, giving a nice triangular shape. Large oval well opened oblique set eyes that held your attention and of a lovely green. For just under 5 months old, this lovely girl had very good boning, substance and weight with a good length to her, on firm set legs, rear feet higher than the front, with

large paws and delightful tufts between toes. I liked the feel and look of her coat, which was of a good length for her age, already showing a wooly undercoat, with a smoother overcoat, complimented by a thick tail, but very much a kitten tail, but showing the length required. A lovely kitten who was such a sweetie to handle, so affectionate and so interested in what was going on. When back in her pen, she sat so regal and confident, just adding to the overall picture, beautifully shown and presented.

2nd Snelling & Burnett's Norsvana Astryd Avanda 67 31ats 11/9/07 Blue silver Tabby & white. Another beautiful girl of lovely type. Lovely triangular shape to head, showing excellent equality to sides. Good long length to profile, almost straight, had slight bump at end. Very good firm chin, good level bite. Correct rounding to forehead. Excellent large ears set high and open with good width to base, showing nice lynx tufts from ears. Lovely large well opened oblique set amber eyes showing a very alert expression. Excellent boning, weight and substance to this girl who has quite a muscular feel to her, set on substantial firm legs, rear higher than front, with large paws with tufts between toes. Lovely coat texture, wooly underneath, with a smother overcoat, showing long coarser hairs on flanks and back, complimented by a long bushy tail to the shoulders, unfortunately there is what appears to be a fixed deviation at the end; I did consult with the duty vet, who feels it will result in a fixed deviation. This was a great shame, as she would have been my winner but unfortunately I had to penalize her, please keep an eye on this. Nevertheless a lovely girl, beautifully shown with an excellent temperament, I see she is the litter sister to the male winner.

AC Ragdoll Bi Colour Male Kitten

2nd 1st w/h Hart's Shamanta Rock And Rollover 66 31ft Cream Bi Colour 24/7/07 quite a small boy for just under 9 months old. Quite good top to head, showing a flat plane, medium ears were held just a little high, cheeks for me lacked the fullness I would have expected for his age, also his muzzle lacked the depth, it needs for balance, weak chin and his bite was very undershot. I did call the duty vet who confirmed this and signed my judge's book. Good eye colour well opened and showing very slight oblique set. Nice even inverted white v from the forehead, extending down covering a nice pink retrouse nose. Whisker pads and chin, not going past the outer aperture of the eye. Although of good boning & weight I would have liked more length to the body, set on firm medium legs, with reasonable large round paws, showing tufts. Cream colouring to ears, mask and on tail were quite red in appearance, the lighting did not help, very clean white bid, with nice white front legs, with the back legs white, level to the underbody, with a small spot of cream at the bottom of the right back leg. A very nice off white colour to the coat, which was a little

short, showing a patch of white on the back, needed a little more show preparation underneath. A very friendly lad, who purred the whole time, sadly his bite and size, prevented me for awarding first today.

Unfortunately both Bi Colour Female kittens were absent

AV Semi LH Senior Adult

1st Carter's Ch Innuendo Delilah 13c6

A beautiful mature Seal tortie Birman girl of lovely type. Beautiful broad rounded head, lovely full cheeks, giving a nice balanced look. Correct medium size ears, set well apart, showing lovely tortie markings to both ears. Beautiful eye shape and lovely colour. Correct profile, showing slight dip, excellent depth to firm chin, good level bite. Correct Seal to nose leather. Dense seal points to mask, legs, tail, of medium length, and full, all points showing correct tortie intermingling, light cream against dark red. Giving a most exquisite contrast to the points. Nice even white front gloves, with good back socks, very nice length to both gauntlets, even, pristine white. Excellent boning, length & weight to this lovely girl, who was beautifully groomed and presented, with a very nice full coat, showing the desired fawn colour on body, with light shading, light brown, & cream, giving a most attractive contrast. I rather liked this beautiful girl, who was beautiful, so serene and a delight to handle and a pleasure to award 1st to.

2nd Morris's Catwo Ladybird 67 31f

Cream & White Norwegian Forest 1/4/05

Very attractive girl of good type. Good triangular head, showing nice equal sides. Correct long straight profile, very slight rounding to forehead evident, very good firm chin, good bite. Large ears, showing good width to base, set high and open, with good head line down to chin, showing the desired triangular look. Very alert large well opened, oval shaped eyes showing oblique set of a nice copper colour. Excellent boning, weight and substance to this lovely girl, who had a good muscular feel to her, body of good length, showing good depth to chest, set on firm legs, rear higher than front, with large round tufted toes, complimented by a long bushy tail, going to the shoulders. A very attractive girl in good condition, showing a very attractive cream colour to head, ears and on body, against the white, quite coarse coat texture underneath, and coarse on top, just needed a little more show preparation but nevertheless nicely shown and so friendly

3rd Fisher's Panzalia Annie Oakley 13c1

Seal Birman 5/9/01 A mature Seal Birman who for me lacked the typical true Birman type, head triangular in shape, cheeks were rather narrow, profile showed slight dip, chin recedes, good bite. Almost round shaped eyes of a good blue. Good even front, gloves with quite good back socks, both gauntlets were of a decent length and even. Very dense seal to ears,

mask, legs and on medium length tail. For just over 6 and have years old this girl was in good condition, good size, boning and weight. Quite full coat that was quite shady, particularly down the back but had some contrasts. A friendly girl, who was well shown, just lacked the typical Birman type for me.

AC Norwegian Forest Adult

1st Douglas's Fernisulven Genevieve 67 20a Blue Tabby 26/3/07. A very young girl but showing a good triangular head, good equality to sides, very good length to straight profile, good depth to firm chin, good bite. Rounding to forehead was clear. Nice large, well opened ears, showing good width to base, set high, with lynx tufts coming from ears, good evident headline from ears down to chin, giving a most attractive triangular look to the head. Correct, alert well opened oblique set eyes of nice amber. I liked the body length, boning & substance to this girl, who although was just 15 months old, carried a good muscular look & feel, set on firm set legs, rear higher than front, with large round tufted toes. Excellent grooming and presentation to this lovely girl, whose coat was of a good length, showing correct tabby markings, undercoat is developing the correct wooly texture, with the top quite smooth, correct long, bushy tail, going up to the shoulders. In all an attractive young girl, who can only but improve as she matures excellent temperament.

2nd Morris's UKGrCh Little Tin Soldier Felia Audak DK 67 14b Odd Eyed Norwegian Forest 5.7/98. Anything but little, Beautiful Norwegian lad who had real presence. Very good triangular head shape, showing good equality to sides, good long straight profile, although I felt the nose was rather broad, which did spoil the overall look. Good ear placement, high and open, showing nice tufts, very good head lines, from ears, down to chin, giving a most attractive V shape to his head. Large well opened eyes, showing a slight oblique set, his right eye looked a little sore. Excellent boning, weight, length and substance to this lovely lad, although just under 10 years old. The grooming and presentation to this lovely lad was sadly lacking, his coat was dirty and was full of big hard knots down his spine at his tail, and he lacked grooming underneath, his tail whilst long and bushy needed groomed. This is a beauty contest above all, what a shame this lovely lad was so badly let down, please give this lovely old lad the grooming he so deserves, he was such a dear old gentleman.

AV Semi LH Debutante Kitten M

1st Sallow's Filensio Blaze Of Glory 66w Seal Mitted Ragdoll 30/10/07. Good size lad for just over 5 months old, showing good ragdoll type, nice broad head, with flat plane, medium sized ears, rounded at tip, showing a slight tilt forward. Good depth to cheeks, with good depth to muzzle, good chin and level bite. Medium length to nose, showing slight

retrouse tip. Large oblique set well opened eyes of a good blue. Nice dense seal to ears, mask, small white blaze on nose. Correct white chin, with white to bib and chest and underbody, up to the tail, medium in length, but bushy, with a clear tapering to tip evident. Nice even white front mittens, extending to angle of the paw and leg back legs were white up to the underbody. Excellent boning and weight to this lad, who was of a good length, with firm round large tufted paws, nice clean pink pads. Nice silky coat, of medium length that was nicely groomed, showing a nice beige colour, contrasting nicely with the points. A very striking young lad who really shone and was a pleasure to judge.

2nd Harrison's Raptinfluff 13c1 4/1/08 A very young Seal Birman lad, just old enough to make the show. Good Birman type, nice broad rounded head, showing quite good full cheeks. Nice medium ears set well apart. Correct profile, showing gentle dip, good depth to chin, bite looked okay. Very expressive almost round eyes of a very good blue. I was pleased to see beautiful dense seal to this lad's ears, mask, and legs and on a medium length, slightly sparse tail. Nice even front white gloves, unfortunately there was a runner well past the stopper pad, on the back of the right glove, good back socks, with good length even gauntlets. Very much the babe today, but although was just over 3 months he was of a reasonable size with quite good weight; he will fill out as he matures. His coat was short but nicely prepared, showing a pleasing golden hue, so important for seals. A very sweet little lad, who was a sweetie to handle, he enjoyed all the fuss. Nicely shown

Seal Colourpointed Ragdoll. 21/9/07 A beautiful mature girl of lovely type. Nice broad head, with correct flat plane, showing good width between medium size, set wide, with pleasing tilt forward, rounded at tips. Good full cheeks, showing a nice developed chin, good bite Very expressive bright large well opened eyes, showing slight oblique set, and of a lovely blue. Lovely even dense seal to, ears, mask, legs and on a nice long bushy tail, tapering to tip. This lovely girl was in excellent condition, good muscular feel to her, showing good length and boning, set on medium firm thick legs, with large rounded paws, showing tufts. A very confident and impressive girl, who at 7 months old was very mature, shown in excellent condition, with a lovely soft silky medium length coat, with beautiful beige throughout, giving a lovely contrast to her points. Beautifully shown with a super nature.

2nd Hutfield's Adatelo Etarre Tatiana 67 31ts 16/12/07 Silver Tabby & White Norwegian Forest

3rd Zech's Zeconna Kiara Rose 64 41sw
Silver Classic & White Maine Coon A very pretty girl showing good type. Correct medium length to head, cheeks are developing nicely, high cheek bones. Good depth to square muzzle, with good firm chin & level bite. Uniform nose length showing width with a shallow concave curve at the nasal bridge, no break or stop evident. Correct large tall ears, set high, with width at base, showing tapering at tip, giving the desired pointed look. Full round eyes spaced apart, showing very slight oblique set, of nice amber. Very good muscular feel to this girl's body, which was of medium length, with proportionate legs, substantial large round paws, toes carried close, 5 in front, 4 behind. Good length to coat that was very soft, showing nice clear Silver with white, complimented by a nice long full tail up to the back of the head. A very attractive girl who was so sweet to handle.

AV Semi LH Neuter Not bred by Exhibitor

This was a very good class of 10 with all present.

1st Plant's Ch Katmea Andall thatJazz 64 31t
Brown Tabby & White Maine Coon 29/12/04 A most attractive mature girl, showing very good type. Correct medium length to head, showing fairly full cheeks with good high cheekbones. Excellent square muzzle, showing good depth to chin & level bite. Correct length to uniform nose, with width and shallow curve concave curve at the nasal bridge, with no break or stop. Large tall ears, with width to base, tapering to a point, giving a pointed look, set well apart and high. Large round eyes, with slight oblique set, of a copper colour. Excellent muscular body with good boning and substance on a large frame, with large substantial firm legs, large round rounded paws. Clear tabby markings throughout coat that was glossy on top with the desired woolly undercoat, increasing in length going down from the head the back and flanks. Nice full breeches, with good ruff at face. Excellent long profuse tail to the shoulder blades. A very striking girl who sat so beautiful and was a dream to handle. A worthy winner in a very good class, well shown.

2nd Gilby's Pr Klassyklogs Kagen 13d
4/2/05 A very handsome auburn & white Turkish lad, excellent substantial broad wedge, with good full cheeks. Correct medium length to nose, straight but showing a barely perceptible dip to profile. Good chin. Nice moderately white large ears that were well feathered, set high on head and close together, showing a most attractive pinkish shell colour to the inside. Very good and even auburn colour to head, not extending past the outer ear or beyond base of the ear, complimented by a very attractive white vertical blaze. Very alert expressive large oval amber oblique set eyes, with pink rims. Very clean white nose excellent long sturdy muscular body, with a good deep chest on medium thick set legs, with nice

rounded tufted feet. This lad was beautifully groomed and presented with a good length to this coat, that was chalk white and gleaming with health, complimented by a full brush full auburn tail, cut off at the roots, giving excellent balance to his body. I really liked this handsome lad who was so beautifully shown and quite a character he loved all the fuss.
